

How to make an alien spaceship!

Hello and welcome to the Spacecraft Instructions Manual!

Here you will find a step-by-step guide to making your very own alien spaceship. All you need is a few materials and the help of an adult.

Let's get started!

Step 1

Gather some spaceship materials:

- 2 paper bowls
- 1 paper cup, yogurt pot or other similarly shaped container
- 1 plastic cup or lid
- scissors
- coloured paints or markers
- tape or PVA glue



Step 2

Stick the 2 paper bowls together to form the body of your ship. You can use either tape or glue to join them.



Step 3

Colour your paper cup to look like flames coming out of your spaceship.



Step 4

Colour your paper bowls.
These will be the main
body of your spaceship.
Try adding windows or engine
parts?



Step 5

Make a captain for your
spaceship by drawing one
on paper then carefully
cutting it out.
What alien creature
will you chose to
fly your ship?



Step 6

Insert your captain into the
plastic cup or lid, (his cabin)
then attach it to the body of
your spaceship.
